- 1. <u>Center</u> your life around God through worship.
 - a. Worship is simply building your life around God,

You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. Matthew 22:37-38

b. How the first church in Jerusalem worshiped

They worshiped together at the Temple each day. Acts 2:46

- 2. Connect with other believers through fellowship.
 - a. Fellowship is learning to love other people in God's family.

All honor to God, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ; for it is his boundless mercy that has given us the privilege of being born again so that we are now members of God's own family. 1 Peter 1:3 (TLB)

This is the church of the living God, which is the pillar and foundation of the truth. 1 Timothy 3:15.

b. God wants us to connect with other believers.

 - a. God doesn't want you to stay a spiritual baby.

You have been believers so long now that you ought to be teaching others. Instead, you need someone to teach you again the basic things about God's word. Hebrews 5:12

- b. God wants you to center your life on Christ.
- 4. Contribute something back through ministry.
 - a. Ministry is something everybody's called to do.

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. 1 Peter 4:10

 - a. Evangelism means"sharing good news."
